Minutes of Monthly Town Board Meeting
Tuesday, September 12, 2017

Chairman, Mike Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:01p.m., immediately following the Special Meeting of the Electors, at the Town Shed, 2181 County Road G, Comstock, WI. Present were Supervisors Richard Naessen and Joe Zaspel; Clerk, Deanne Moravitz; Treasurer Sue Rouzer and 8 town residents.

Approval of August Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Naessen/Zaspel to approve the minutes as submitted by the clerk. Motion Carried.

Approval of Treasurer’s Report – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to approve the August Treasurers Report as submitted by the Treasurer. Motion Carried.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to pay the bills as submitted by the Clerk. Motion Carried.

Mr. Kindschy, Turtle Lake School District – Mr. Kindschy gave an update on the work being done with funds approved thru the last school.

Cumberland Fire District Contract – postponed until next meeting.

Town Shed – postponed until further notice.

Period of Public Comment – Discussion and request to cut brush back on Pipe Lake Road/220th and on 205th. Discussion regarding delinquent taxes.

Supervisor Reports – Supervisor Naessen expressed concern about motorists that don’t heed to roadwork signs and do not slow down. Other construction areas utilize temporary speed bump strips and requested, in addition to more road work signs, a set be purchased for the township.

Supervisor Zaspel fielded a request to have a designated swim area marked out at the Pipe Lake Boat Landing. This will be brought to the attention of the Pipe Lakes Association for further discussion.

Road Maintenance Report – Blacktop will be laid on inside corners around the township as well as more patching as needed. Long Lake Ln road, where scrub seal was applied, is blowing up with multiple new potholes and blacktop breaking up. Fahrner will be called in to inspect and recommend remedy.

Gravel is currently being crushed in the Strenke pit with no reported issues with truck traffic or excessive noise levels.
