<u>Storm Cleanup Recap</u>; payment options for cleanup – All town right-of-way's have been cleared of major debris with continuing efforts to remove low hanging branches and tree's that pose a danger. There is a need to borrow funds to pay for the cleanup. We are expecting FEMA assistance and reimbursement. A Special Meeting of the Electors will be posted to approve the borrowing.

Motion by Lowe, Seconded by Zaspel to utilize \$60,000 from the Equipment Fund for emergency use to pay S&S Forestry \$36,062.50; Hugo's Tree Care \$9,620.00; Hopkin's Sand & Gravel, Inc \$12,124.00; balance to be used for invoices not yet received. These funds will be replenished when FEMA reimbursement is issued. Motion Carried.

<u>Period of Public Comment</u> – Resident asked why our municipality didn't receive assistance from the National Guard. Our area was not deemed as a critical area. The National Guard was utilized in area's where roads were completely impassable for greater lengths of time and distance.
