Minutes of Monthly Town Board Meeting Tuesday, February 9, 2016

Chairman, Mike Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Supervisors, Richard Naessen and Joe Zaspel; Treasurer, Sue Rouzer; Clerk, Deanne Moravitz, and 2 town residents.

Approval of January Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to approve the minutes as submitted by the clerk. Motion Carried.

Approval of Treasurer's Report – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to approve the January Treasurers Report as submitted by the Treasurer. Motion Carried.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to pay the bills as submitted by the Clerk. Naessen asked about the amount for the fire district contract: it's the annual contract with Cumberland Fire District. Motion Carried.
