Minutes of Monthly Town Board Meeting
Wednesday, February 13, 2019

Chairman, Mike Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Shed, 2181 County Road G, Comstock, WI. Present were Supervisor Richard Naessen and Joe Zaspel; Clerk, Deanne Moravitz and Treasurer Sue Rouzer.

Approve January Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to approve the minutes as presented. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report – January Treasurers Report was reviewed and accepted as submitted by the Treasurer.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Naessen to pay the bills as submitted. Motion Carried.

Pipe Lake Church Parking Lot Sanding – Motion by Zaspel to sand the Pipe Lake Church Parking Lot when requested and charge per fee schedule for work performed. Seconded by Naessen. Motion Carried.

Weed Control at Pipe Lake Boat Landing – The Pipe Lakes District requested public assistance from the Town of Johnstown for funds to help cover the cost of landing monitors at the boat landing on Pipe Lake. Motion by Naessen to decline contribution to Pipe Lakes District from the Town of Johnstown. Seconded by Anderson. Motion Carried.

Town Advocacy Council – The TAC provides legislative advocacy support for towns throughout the state. Motion by Zaspel to approve paying membership dues to the 2019 Towns Advocacy Council. Seconded by Naessen. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Reports – Zaspel: ditch brushing has been completed. As more brushing/trimming needs are identified additional work will be performed to keep rights-of-way safely cleared of debris.
