Minutes of Monthly Town Board Meeting
Tuesday, July 10, 2018

Chairman, Mike Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Supervisors, Joe Zaspel and Richard Naessen; Clerk, Deanne Moravitz; Treasurer, Sue Rouzer and 5 town residents and 1 guest.

Approval of June Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Naessen/Zaspel to approve the minutes as submitted by the clerk. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report – Reviewed and accepted June Treasurers Report as submitted by the Treasurer.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Anderson to pay all the bills as presented by Clerk. Motion Carried.

The Regular August Monthly Town Board Meeting will be held at the Town Shed; 2181 County Road G, Comstock, WI on Wednesday, August 15, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.

Period of Public Comment – Dick Hollar was present to report on recent happenings with the Pipe Lake Association.

Pipe Lake Ln: There has been excessive speeding reported by residents on Pipe Lake Ln – what can be done? Residents have requested that no grading be done until further notice to let natural speed bumps form; requested to have Polk County Sheriff's Department monitor the traffic in the area; place a flashing speed monitoring system in the area for a short time.

Continuing Obligations Notice RE: Old Fuel tanks at 1977 Polk Barron St. – discussion was had and it was determined to let the case close.

Fire Numbers – Installed 50 new fire numbers in 2017. Motion by Anderson to continue updating fire number by ordering another 50 numbers and posts. Seconded by Zaspel. Motion Carried.

220th Ave. – Discussed details and reasons for work to be done on 220th.

Town Hall Updates - we are still waiting on estimates.

Supervisor Reports – Zaspel: There's been reports of pontoons parking in the swim area on the north end of Pipe Lake near the boat launch. This is causing safety concerns for those the use the area for swimming. Can an area be designated for swimming? Pipe Lakes Association will send out a notice to locals regarding pontoons at the boat launch area.

Road Maintenance Report – Missing curve sign on 190th; sign will be ordered and replaced. Patching on 240th continues. 190th continues to break up; Motion by Naessen to contact Fahrner and do some spray patching with a maximum expenditure of \$5000. Seconded by Anderson. Motion Carried.

Adjournment – Motion by Naessen, seconded by Zaspel to adjourn the meeting at 7:36 p.m. Motion Carried.
