Approve May Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Zaspel/Lowe to approve the minutes as submitted. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report – May Treasurers Report was reviewed and accepted as submitted by the Treasurer.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Lowe to pay the bills as submitted. Motion Carried.

Fahrner Asphalt Sealers Presentation – Jason Fahrner showed a presentation to the board to explain the processes of GSP-88 and Scrub Sealing along with proposal for upcoming projects. Motion by Anderson to advertise for Crack Sealing/Flex Patching, Scrub Seal, Chip Seal, GSB-88 Applications to the following roads: W Pipe Lake Lane, 235<sup>th</sup> Ave., 205<sup>th</sup> Ave., 24<sup>th</sup> St., 220<sup>th</sup> Ave., 15<sup>th</sup> St. – 230<sup>th</sup> St., West Pipe Lake Court, 45<sup>th</sup> St. Seconded by Lowe. Motion Carried.

Pipe Lake Lane Bid Opening – There were 2 bids received for the advertised Pipe Lake Lane reconstruction project. Antczak Construction price was \$43,871.00. Erickson Excavating was \$35,750.00. Motion by Anderson to accept the bid from Erickson Excavating to complete the reconstruction of Pipe Lake Lane per the proposal specifications at a price of \$35,750.00. Seconded by Lowe. Motion Carried.

Period of Public Comment – Discussion: porta potty at the Pipe Lake Boat Landing, swimming, and other issues. Dick Hollar reported that a new weekend monitor has been hired for checking boats.
