Minutes of Monthly Town Board Meeting
Tuesday May 13, 2020

Chairperson, Mike Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:36 p.m. at the Town Shed, 2181 County Road G, Comstock, WI. Present were Supervisors Joe Zaspel and Dan Lowe; Clerk, Deanne Moravitz; Treasurer Sue Rouzer and 2 town residents.

Approve April Town Meeting Minutes – Motion Zaspel/Lowe to approve the minutes as submitted. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report – April Treasurers Report was reviewed and accepted as submitted by the Treasurer.

Approve Vouchers for Payment of Bills – Motion Zaspel/Lowe to pay the bills as submitted. Motion Carried.

Pipe Lake Lane Road Work – Logging options have been completed. Hugo Tree Service will be removing debris in ditches. Doug Rouzer donated space to stage debris. This space may also be available to town residents in the future.

Period of Public Comment – none

Clerks Report – FEMA Projects for Volunteer Labor and Debris Cleanup are complete. Payment will be sent to the State of WI and then on to the Town. Once the state receives the funds, they have 30 days to send reimbursement to the Town.

Supervisor Reports – Dan Lowe asked that in the letter that will be sent to property owners on PLL (Pipe Lake Lane), include the location that Doug Rouzer has designated and donated for tree and leaf debris only.

Joe Zaspel asked about sneeze guards for future elections. We will reevaluate as we near the August Primary.

Storm Debris was staged at The Strenke Pit last summer. **Motion by Lowe to pay \$2400 to LeRoy Strenke for the use of the Strenke Pit for staging debris post July 19, 2019. Seconded by Zaspel. Motion Carried.**

Road Bid: Motion by Anderson to publicly advertise for road bids to clear .5 miles of west ditch on PLL; remove stumps, cut ditch, grade, landscape and reseed. Project to be completed no later than September 1, 2020. Deadline for bids shall be June 3, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. Bids will be viewed and awarded at the June 9, 2020 Regular Monthly Board Meeting. Seconded by Lowe. Motion Carried.

Road Maintenance Report – 4 culverts will be replaced; 2 on Glovers Lake Ln; 1 on 183rd; 1 on 235th/45th intersection.

2 road projects, Pipe Lake Intersection and Long Lake Ln, will have shouldering completed in the next month. Anderson met with Fahrner and shared their recommendations for crack sealing and scrub sealing of several town roads. More discussion will be had on these projects.
