<u>Period of Public Comment</u> – Dick Hollar reported on a recent situation at the Pipe Lake Boat landing where invasive aquatic plant, curly leaf pond weed, was observed on a boat trailer. Owner was located. DNR was contacted and situation was handled.

Deb Schadegg reported that 3 citizens were recently threatened; incident was reported to local authorities for further investigation. What is the status of the signs for posting the speed limits? They have been ordered and will be posted as soon as they arrive – ETA: mid June.

Carolyn Vance stated that trucks have been trucking, but that she hardly noticed, as they were traveling at lower speeds and not using the Jake Brakes.

Paul Pett presented the Christ Lutheran Church Perpetual Care petition and requested that the Chairman sign. Acting Chairman, Naessen signed.

<u>Supervisors Report</u> – Zaspel: Brad will be working on patching the pot holes on town roads. Long Lake Boat Landing improvements have been completed and appear to be holding up well.

<u>Road Maintenance</u> – Naessen: When will roadside and ditch mowing be completed? Evenson Construction is contracted to mow the road ditches twice during the summer/fall with first mowing to be completed by July 4th and second mowing to be completed by October 1st.

Road Inspection was completed – missing signs were identified and will be ordered. Patching, crack sealing, erosion repairs and some chip sealing needs were identified. Report was filed with WISLAR.
