<u>Period of Public Comment</u> – Dick Hollar reported on behalf of the Pipe Lake District: culvert project has been delayed due to weather. They were able to secure a one year extension on the Protection Grant that will help fund the culvert project. Fish Sticks with be dropped into the lakes over the winter again – feedback from those already places has been very positive in terms of improving fish habitat in the lakes.

<u>2015 Ditch Mowing Contract</u> – Motion by Zaspel, seconded by Rouzer to approve the 2015 Mowing Contract with Evenson Excavating. Motion Carried.

<u>Supervisors Reports</u> – Rouzer asked the county plow trucks had cleared 195^{th} [The DNR Road] all the way to the turnaround. Brad was in there today [11/12/14] and cleared it.

<u>Road Maintenance</u> – 2014 gravel crushing is complete; 1211 tons of reject sand and 9207 tons of gravel. Work is complete on 195^{th} ; receipts will be submitted to the DNR for 75% reimbursement of costs accrued.
